- More than 20 military and civilian helicopters from our collection will be on display, including some not normally open to the public
- Climb aboard historic aircraft and hear from experts on their history and operation
- Aircraft on display will include a Sikorsky CH-54 "Skycrane," a Bell UH-1B "Huey," our Gyrodyne QH-50C "DASH" Navy drone, and components from an award-winning human-powered helicopter, along with many others
- The event will also include a 12:30 presentation from Daniel Libertino, President of Sikorsky Historical Archives, on the history of Sikorsky Aircraft

Helicopter Day will run from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with the Museum and the *Wings 'n Things* Gift Shop staying open until 5:00 p.m.
